ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I have no committee amendments. Senator Schrock, I have AM2673 with a note you wish to withdraw that amendment.

SENATOR SCHROCK: That's correct.

SENATOR CUDABACK: That amendment is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, anything further on the bill?

ASSISTANT CLERK: In that case, Senator Schrock would offer AM3067. (Legislative Journal pages 1034-1035.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, to open on AM3067.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this substitute amendment strikes the provisions allowing teleconferencing. After consulting with the Chair of the Government Committee, the amendment clarifies that the board may contract to provide and receive services and technical assistance. This last is a change in the sentence structure and does not substantially change the bill. In consultation with Senator Schimek, why I understand this would set a new precedence and she was not willing to go that way. And under her advice we have offered this amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President. I just wanted to thank Senator Schrock for the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any further discussion? No lights on. Senator Schrock. He waives closing. Question before the body is adoption of AM3067. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Question before the body is adoption of the Schrock amendment, AM3067, 3-0-6-7 rather. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Schrock's amendment.
