SENATOR BEUTLER: I would take call-in votes, Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: We will, as soon as the Clerk is ready. The house is under call. Senator Janssen, Senator Redfield, Senator Jones, Senator Mossey. Senator Beutler has authorized call-in votes. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Thompson voting yes, Senator Bourne voting yes, Senator Jensen voting yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 1118 does advance. I do raise the call. Members, I know it's getting late, but if possible we can get through these next three or four bills, I know the members would appreciate it. Thank you. Mr. Clerk, next bill.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1107 was introduced by Senator Raikes. (Read title.) The bill was read for the first time on January 15 of this year, referred to the Education Committee. The committee reports the bill to General File with no committee amendments attached.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Raikes, to open.

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you, Mr. President and members. I'm still reeling over our donnybrook on attestation engagements but I'm going to try to gather my wits and move on. LB 1107 would clarify that the full-time equivalent students used in the calculations for the Nebraska Scholarship Act must be eligible students. It's a technical correction brought to us by the Postsecondary Coordinating Commission. I'd urge your support. Thank you.
