I meet with, if she would be available, Jody Gittins, the committee staff, and with the people who are interested in this bill and in the language in this amendment in the Rotunda as soon as I get done speaking, we can look at crafting some language. If we can work through things now and come up with another amendment, then I can submit that on General File, which would be my preference. And if we've got the language worked out, then that hopefully won't be a problem. If not, then we will proceed from there. But I would ask anyone from...the representatives from the Farm Bureau or the Cattlemen or others to meet me in the lobby, and we can discuss this amendment and how we might come to some agreeable language at this time. And if they would meet me in the lobby, we can begin working on that. And perhaps a modified version I can reintroduce still on General File. With that, Mr. Clerk, I will pull AM3168 at this time. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have to the bill, Senator Beutler, AM3037.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Beutler, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator...Mr. Speaker, that amendment will no longer pertain, since the introducer of the bill wishes to withdraw the body to which the amendment would apply. So I would withdraw the amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: It is withdrawn, Senator Beutler. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have, Senator Beutler, AM3107.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, this amendment strikes five sections that the introducer has agreed to strike by another amendment, so I would withdraw this one also.
