SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Schrock, I'm sorry. Were you speaking?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, I was talking. (Laughter) And you know, I will say something, though, about the bill. This bill contains an annual fee for the livestock producers. And they do not pay an annual fee at the current time. At the current time, when you set up a livestock facility, you pay an inspection fee, you have...for the privilege to operate a livestock facility. You pay an application fee for...it's a one-time fee. This will set up an annual fee, and that will be new to the provisions of this bill. And so the livestock industry has swallowed a little hard on this one, but they're accepting it. I will say this much. The program that was passed that we're using at the current time did not generate the funds that we thought it would generate. And probably part of that is because a lot of the smaller producers in the state have gone out of business, and so there's not as many livestock producers in the state as there used to be. And the ones that are operating, of course, are bigger. So with that, I will give the rest of my time back to the Chair.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I would like to ask Senator Schrock a question.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Schrock, would you yield, please?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Schrock, I'm joining you so that we can give time.

SENATOR SCHROCK: All right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would you turn to page 21 of the...

SENATOR SCHROCK: I will.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...committee amendment? Are you on that page?

SENATOR SCHROCK: I think I am, yes.
