SENATOR SCHROCK: I hear you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...that I looked at that are not too large.

SENATOR SCHROCK: And I'm not sure, Senator Chambers, if you want me to follow up here, in a case of a modification or an expansion, if they would have to file a notifica...in a local newspaper. So I can't answer that right now.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And I'm just wondering how many times they would have to publish, if they are required to publish, how many times it should be--once, or once a week for three weeks--because it doesn't say at all. But if you will look at page 20, it's another of those kind of amendments I had offered on other bills. And I'm going to look, starting in line 18. You see the words "natural resources district or districts and the county board or boards," then it says, "of the counties." I think to be consistent we should say "of the county or counties," because in some instances this may affect only one county. And since in line 18 we talk about county board or boards, it's clear we're talking about county or counties. So at some point I would just offer that.

SENATOR SCHROCK: That would be acceptable, Senator Chambers. Good point.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. And I don't know if Senator Beutler has completed his discussion yet, so I will see what develops from this point. Let me ask Senator Schrock a question. Senator Schrock, have you been given any information that would affect your opinion of Senator Beutler's amendment that is before us now?

SENATOR SCHROCK: I have not. But maybe we should give Senator Beutler some time, to see where he's at with it. Because I'm in the dark, and you're in the dark, and so we don't know where we're at. But...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Except that I support...

SENATOR SCHROCK: ...but I see somebody coming to talk to him,
