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sites," and so forth. I had discussed this briefly with Senator Schrock. This is not an objective standard that can be used and applied to all situations. It does not give notice to those who might be affected by it of a standard. What does "economically" mean? Well, to a moneybags like "Deacon" Jones, it means one thing, to an impoverished person such as myself, who does not have two nickels to rub together, it means something else. We should not put anything into a regulatory scheme which can invite arbitrariness, or create the appearance of favoritism. If a standard is placed before the public, before it can have the status of a valid standard it has to let the people who are going to be affected by it know in advance what it means. Nobody knows what the term "economically" means. Even if a person would offer a definition, it would wind up being more in the nature of a description. We would talk about this term relative to a specific situation. We do not define a word and apply it to all situations to see whether or not they come under the definition. We, if we use this word, are creating an invitation for unfairness. Somebody is going to make a decision based on best management practices. That is what is being defined, and the word "economically" is a part of that definition. So I will go up to line 13 and begin to read, on page 7, line 13: "Best management practices means schedules of activities, prohibitions, maintenance procedures, and other management practices found to be the most effective methods," then the new language, "based on the best available technology economically," available (sic). I don't think we ought to say "economically." It should be based on the best available technology. If you notice in line 15 the words "and practicable" were stricken. So I would like to ask Senator Schrock a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, would you yield?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, I would yield.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Schrock, before those two words were stricken, we would have a term that would say the most effective and practicable methods. Why were the words "and practicable" stricken, if you remember or if you know?
