SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It seems to me that we should want the best technology available. If it's too costly, it's not available. So I wonder if, instead of talking about "economically," you could put something in front of the word "available," such as "reasonably" available, but that may not do it either. I don't want to do away with "best technology," but I don't want to see the word "economically" left in place, because it allows a difference in application based on the individual who comes. Let's say Senator Schrock has a multimillion-dollar operation and he can afford...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You may continue, Senator Chambers. Your time is next.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. With his multimillion-dollar operation, and that's how much he nets, he probably would have to run a mint on the side if he's in farming and he's going to net \$3 million in Nebraska. But anyway, for the sake of my example, he could afford any technology out there. We're not saying experimental technology, we're not saying theoretical; we're saying available. And again, we have a word that can mean different things to different people. If it is too costly, I would say it is not available. Somebody else would say, well, I see it differently. If it is a type of technology which, if applied, would work and achieve the goal of cleaning up waste or making this change that is to take place achievable, then it is available. That means it's a tool in the box, no matter how much it costs. But from my standpoint, I would say the tool is in the box but it costs so much that it's not available, meaning it's outside the reach of those who are going to be required or expected to use it. So maybe what I need to do, listen to a little more discussion, join in it myself, then consider withdrawing this amendment at this time. But the idea embodied in the amendment is something I won't let
