however, it remains substantially the same and with the same substantive provisions. With that, I'll conclude the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Senator Jensen. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, frauds, cheats are not my cup of "tay." Americans would say tea. But I wondering, Senator Jensen, have you ever heard of a guy called de Torquemada? Have you ever heard of the Inquisition, the Spanish Inquisition? Have you ever heard of that?
