SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Jensen, they had another punishment where they would put a person's feet in iron boots and put those boots in fire. And at first it wasn't very unpleasant but after a point was reached where the metal glowed red, the person was in extreme agony. Were you aware of such an activity before I mentioned it here?

SENATOR JENSEN: No, not of the boots and fire.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, now that I mentioned it to you, would you object to an amendment that would add that to the bill?

SENATOR JENSEN: I would.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm sure you heard of the rack, haven't you?

SENATOR JENSEN: I have.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would you be opposed to including the rack as a punishment in this bill?

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes, however, there are times that I'd like to stretch on one, but...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: One minute.

SENATOR JENSEN: ...I would be opposed to that. Yes, I would.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Jensen, have you heard of the water torture, and it takes various forms, but where they might put a piece of cloth down a person's throat and let water drip on it and drip and drip and let the water do down and the cloth go down with it? Would you be opposed to that being added?

SENATOR JENSEN: I would be opposed to that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Jensen, who drafted this, if you know?

SENATOR JENSEN: I really don't know, Senator, but I can find out.
