SENATOR CHAMBERS: We're talking about a civil penalty.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And that is in addition to any other remedies, right? Okay, we get to the civil penalty. Then in line 6, do you see the language, "In addition to civil penalties"?

SENATOR ERDMAN: I do.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do you see that?

SENATOR ERDMAN: I do.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And that brings us into damages, right? Three...triple damages, we'll say for ease of reference, for my purposes. So we now get into triple damages. Would you agree with that?

SENATOR ERDMAN: That is the language.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Then in line 11, "in addition to penalties and damages," the costs and attorney's fees of the state will be paid if the case goes against the defendant. Do you agree with that? That's what the language says.

SENATOR ERDMAN: That is what the language says, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then in line 15, the liability is joint and several, which means everybody can be hit, or any individual, or any combination of individuals in the group. But you do see that language also, "joint and several"?

SENATOR ERDMAN: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Would you go to line...to page 11?
