SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Erdman, on the fifth division.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. And Senator Schimek, every time you stand up to ask the question, I'll stand up behind you and say I think that's also an appropriate idea, and I would support your efforts. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Erdman. Senator Smith. He waives the opportunity to speak. Any further senators wishing to speak? Seeing none, Senator Schrock, you're recognized to close on FA1507.

SENATOR SCHROCK: In light of the discussion, I would be willing to accept some kind of a sunset, possibly on the second round of debate. I will tell you this--the task force has been frugal with the money allotted to them. No one gets any pay. And so I think...and some of them are able to write off their expenses, not even charge it to the state, if they're a part of an NRD, or part of a municipality. So not everyone is even billing their expenses to the task force. So it's been very frugal, and I think it will continue to be that way. But in light of the discussion, I would be willing to sit down with someone between now and Select File and discuss a possible sunset. With that, I would ask for your advancement of this proposal.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. You've heard the closing on the fifth division of the divided committee amendments, FA1507. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is the fifth division of the divided committee amendments to LB 962. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.
