has used it. But let's kind of see how the budget discussions shake out. I have confidence in Senator Wehrbein and members of the Appropriations Committee, Senator Beutler, that we'll do the right thing. And like I said, it does pain me for those people to stand up and say, let's just take it out of the Environmental Trust, they don't amount...they don't do anything. Well they do amount to something and they do do something, and we should do all we can to protect those funds. So with that, I would be willing to delay that debate. But in the meantime, we can sure talk about it. But I think probably it's prudent to talk about it off the floor amongst us and try to reach some consensus between now and Select File. Thank you for your time.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Senator Hartnett, followed by Senator Erdman and others.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. President, members of the body. Senator Schrock, do you know how much money is in the Environmental Trust each year that they give out for...?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator Hartnett...

SENATOR HARTNETT: Someone said \$8 million. Is that...?

SENATOR SCHROCK: I'm thinking it's \$9 million, but maybe \$8 million is right...\$8 million to \$9 million, Senator Wehrbein says. And Senator Wehrbein maybe should answer this...

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah, maybe Senator Wehrbein...

SENATOR SCHROCK: But...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR SCHROCK: ...we have already confiscated some of their funds, have we not? And so if you would take \$2.5 million out of the Environmental Trust Fund, how much is left? Do you have an answer to that, Senator Wehrbein?
