SENATOR CUDABACK: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do see five hands. The question before the body is, shall debate cease? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on ceasing debate on FA1513. Have you all voted who care to? The question before the body is to call the question. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted to the question on ceasing debate? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to cease debate.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Debate does cease. Senator Schrock, you're recognized to close on FA1513.

SENATOR SCHROCK: This is the municipal part of the bill. It has nothing to do with funding. I would ask for your consideration.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question before the body is adoption of FA1513, the eleventh component of the divided committee amendments. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on FA1513, the eleventh component of the divided committee amendments to LB 962. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of component FA1513.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, committee amendment FA1514, the twelfth division, Section 92 of the bill, deals with water for environmental purposes. (Legislative Journal pages 1098-1100.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, you're recognized to open on FA1514 of the divided committee amendments.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this is the provision that allows water wells to be used to augment water supplies for environmental purposes. I would ask for your advancement of this division.
