Senator Beutler's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: Senator Beutler, I assume the floor amendment goes away at this time, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Right.

CLERK: Okay, thank you. Mr. President, I have nothing further pending to the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Back to discussion of the bill, itself, advancement to E & R Initial, LB 962A. Open for discussion. Seeing no lights on, Senator Schrock. He waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is, shall LB 962A be advanced to E & R Initial? All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is advancement of LB 962A to E & R Initial. Have you all voted on the advancement who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 962A.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. LB 962A does advance. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, new resolution, LR 261 by Senator Hartnett. That will be laid over. Senator Bourne offers LB 914A. (Read title.)
