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plan doesn't seek to provide services closer to home than what's already available, then our plan is flawed. And I think that that has been the tenor and that's been the discussion that we as a committee have had. However, we'll go back to why Region I has done what it's done. The law enforcement in Region I literally were hiring individuals to either staff their locations or to transport individuals from their location to different communities such as Hastings in order to receive the care or services that those individuals through Region I thought could be provided more locally. Yes, there are still individuals from our area that get transported to different parts of the state for services. That is happening now. It is less than it was before. It will continue to decrease. But there will probably always be a demand somewhere. And so I am still interested in what happens with the rest of this bill. But I can speak to what Region I has done. They looked at the situation and said, we can do this, we can do it more cost-effective for ourselves, for the law enforcement, and for the patient, as far as being able to make sure that they have the services necessary as close to home as practical. They also looked to the state and they said, we can save you the money of putting those individuals in those facilities that you're going to use, and we can use that...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR ERDMAN: ...at home. However, the problem wasn't, yeah, we're going to give you every dollar you save us, we're going to give you that instead; we got a couple hundred thousand dollars to create the system, which is now called Homeward Bound. That has been a success. The recidivism rate is extremely low, extremely low. It is to be held up as an example, I think, from the information that I have, of how this could work. And as we go down this process, you're going to begin to see more regions and more areas of the state coming up to speed on some of these community-based services on their own time line. That is why I think there needs to be some flexibility in LB 1083, to allow for that. What happens when Region I does it, and has done it already, and is successful in doing it? They get held up as a model. They haven't gotten a whole lot more support to do it, but they're doing it now. Could they provide more services?
