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So I want assurances, I want to know exactly where we are in the process, before we close these facilities. Now it was also explained to me out in the lobby, at least from their perspective, that you can't just put all the services in place and then close the facilities, that you've got...it's kind of a balancing act, and you have to be able to maybe shut down some services that are now provided at the regional centers, and start up some other community services. I'm not sure exactly. But it couldn't be a...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...a one-step process here and a one-step process here. It had to be a balancing act. So my question is--and I'm never going to get to all my questions--why do we have to shut down both regional centers at once? Why couldn't the plan call for a two-step process whereby you do start working on those community services, you do start getting some of them in place. Then you close down one of the regional centers, then you free up some money to get some more community services going, and then you close down the other regional center. Maybe that's not a perfect plan, but I just want some assurances that we're not doing the wrong thing by the people who need those services the most. And past experiences haven't always been very comforting. I'll turn on my light again, Mr. Speaker, because I'm not going to get to the rest of my questions.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Landis. Is Senator Landis...you timed that just right, Senator. You may speak.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature. I'd just like to take one moment to say, you know, for an argument and a debate as lengthy as this is likely to be, we ought to spend a moment thinking about the areas of agreement that are relatively large in this field. One, that in fact mental health has been somewhat overlooked and needs resources. My guess is that everybody could agree to that. Number two, that there is a need for residential care, there is a kind of client who needs services that can only be given in a regional
