First off...well, here's Senator Wehrbein. Thank you, Senator Engel. Senator, thanks for your help in explaining how the lines 22 through 24 relate back to page 17. I think I understand that, that the totals on page 17 are sort of a sum of those numbers. But let me press with you, if I could, a little bit further. If you want to actually look at the agency or the individual appropriations and cuts, I think, am I correct, that go into that page 17 list, you go back to Appendix A, page 26?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wehrbein, please.

SENATOR RAIKES: So Appendix A would list all budget adjustments and then Appendix B would be just the reductions. Is that correct?
