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Game and Parks.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay, so in the funds there, you've got a current biennium of \$16,300 and then a \$26,000, is that General Fund money?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: No, that's all cash.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay, so probably that would be Environmental Trust money that's going to be used for that.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, this is an effort to save the Ferguson House and put the Environmental Trust into that as an office space and there is some money available to renovate that, and then the Environmental Trust would lease that for office space.

SENATOR RAIKES: Well, probably you're anticipating, if you go to the next page, on page 32, under #65 and I think item number 900 or 600, 900, renovations/improvements to the Ferguson House.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR RAIKES: So now is that money also, \$58,623, is that money also Environmental...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's revolving funds. I don't have the sheet with me on that, Senator Raikes, but that's revolving funds; money coming from the rent that they would pay and source...it's sources other than General Fund.

SENATOR RAIKES: So none of that line, then, the 58 number plus the 19 and so on, none of that would be General Fund expenditures?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's generally true. Something in my mind triggers there may be \$15,000 or \$20,000 of General. I'm thinking on the phone, I shouldn't, but I'll have to check that. But, generally, there is not General Funds. I think there might be a small amount, but most of it is going to be paid in the future with under the rent and some outside money that's coming in which would go into the revolving fund.
