SENATOR WEHRBEIN: And off the top of my head, I think that's what that would be.

SENATOR JONES: Okay. One more, line...number 32, School Lands and Funds.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, right.

SENATOR JONES: Don't they get all their money from the rent of the land out there?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Just a minute. I'm going to go back to 27.

SENATOR JONES: Okay.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: You notice, we did take that...this next year out of the Highway Cash Fund. On line 27, if you go clear to the end, that's a zero.

SENATOR JONES: Right.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: We've reduced that this year and that is no longer going to be General Funds, so I wanted to call that to your attention. Now, what's your other line?

SENATOR JONES: The other line is on School Lands and Funds, 32.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay.

SENATOR JONES: Don't they get all their money from the rent of the school lands?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Now I would guess that this is the surveyor part of that. We do some General Funds in the surveyor's office who falls under Educational Lands and Funds.

SENATOR JONES: They've got their own surveyors, though. I just was...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, they do, but Mr. Brown is our state
