SPEAKER BROMM: Time.

SENATOR JONES: Okay. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Excuse me. Before we proceed with Senator Chambers' time, Mr. Clerk, do you have an announcement?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I do. The Executive Board will meet under the north balcony at 11:00. That's Executive Board, north balcony, at 11:00.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I hope the Executive Board members heard that we'll meet under the balcony at 11:00, and I've talked to all of you so you know what it is we'll be doing and it won't take long, but it will be very good. Mr. President and members of the Legislature, there is something that I want to do to try to help facilitate our process this session. And I touched on it earlier, and rather than debate my specific amendment that is before you now, because it's clear what it is, to take money from the State Fair, I don't need to take a lot of time on that. If we would agree to move all of the budget bills in one vote off General File, before you roll over in a dead faint, think about it. Whatever we're going to find controversial on General File, we're not going to resolve on General File permanently. It's going to be debated here for I don't know how long, then it's going to be debated on Select File also. If we got to Select File, then everything is compressed and we have to come forth with what it is we want to do on these bills, and the budget bill cannot be used as a stratagem. I'd like to ask Senator Landis a question or two if he would consent to answer.
