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SENATOR BOURNE: And that's also assuming that we'd go to \$1.10 levy authority?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR BOURNE: That's also assuming 6.9 percent revenue growth in 2005 and 6.8 percent revenue growth in 2006?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR BOURNE: Numbers that we haven't seen in a number of years, we haven't seen around...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: They are historical over a 20-year period, Senator Bourne, so...

SENATOR BOURNE: I understand. Going over to, in line 38 of page 7 of the blue, where it talks about negative .5 percent revenue growth for Fiscal Years 2002-2003,...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...that was an actual number?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. And then the 3.9 percent over there for 2003-2004, that's projected, based on current receipts, or...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...is that a real number as well?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: 3.9 would be real; 4.1 would be still part of an estimate.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. So do you know what 1 percent ..each 1 percent equals?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: In revenue growth?
