If I take a position, the position is mine. I don't hide behind anybody. And I mean what I say. If we don't take the money out of the fair board at this point, or take this money from this agricultural society or however it's phrased in the bill, it's no sweat off my nose. But I promise you I will ask for a division of the question and I will make another promise. I will not leave the floor. I will have something to say, maybe not a whole lot. I will promise you I'll say something on every division of the question. Every one of those divisions, I promise you I will have something to say. And if I have to stay till midnight to do it, I will be here. I will not desert the ship, I will not desert my colleagues,...
