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SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Maxwell, what you said is accurate, but I'd have to make it clear what my intent would be.

SENATOR MAXWELL: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. If the money is taken out at this point, then I would...well first of all, I'm going to withdraw the bracket motion under any circumstance.

SENATOR MAXWELL: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm not going to take it to a vote. My motion would be up there. We would take a vote on it, because we just about have to. We're not going to get anything else done that would delay taking a vote on it unless people would talk on it. But if nobody talks on it, I would have to take a vote on it. If they vote to take that money out, then I would let the discussion on the remainder of the committee amendment go until a decision is reached by the Speaker as to when that motion to suspend the rules and do all the other action would take place. If a decision is taken to do that this afternoon, the committee amendment would be withdrawn so that that suspension motion could come up first. The committee amendment would immediately be refiled behind that, because the way the suspension motion would go is to suspend the rules so that a vote could be taken, one vote on all of them. A second vote would adopt the committee amendments on one vote that are pending to these other bills, so that the package put together by the Appropriations Committee would be left intact. Then a vote would be taken to advance all of those bills with one vote. That's what would happen. And I felt I should explain, instead of just saying yes or no.

SENATOR MAXWELL: That's what I get for asking. No, thank you, Senator. No, I appreciate it. I guess at this point then I may well support Senator Chambers' amendment regarding the appropriation for the State Fair. But I probably will not support, whatever the procedural mechanism is, to just grab all the budget bills and move them on to Select File, almost as if it was a consent calendar type of procedure. I was more persuaded by Senator Bourne's arguments this morning. It just
