SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...of all the areas that we spend money on.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Back to discussion of AM3216 to the committee amendments. Senator Kremer, followed by Senators Schimek, Chambers, Bourne, Thompson, Maxwell, Stuhr, and Jensen. Senator Bourne, you have spoken three times. I'm sorry. Senator Kremer. He waives the opportunity. Senator Schimek. Senator Schimek waives her opportunity. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I'm not going to try to hold off taking a vote on my amendment. If the body is of a mind to vote it down, then I don't mind that being done. And I promise you that I will do what I said. Now, if I were some of you sitting out there, and one of the senators were saying what I'm saying, I would not let my attitude toward that senator blind me to the realities of the situation we confront with 16 days left in the session. I'm not talking now about whether we suspend the rules and move all the bills with one vote. I'm talking about this one amendment, which would take that money out of the budget bill. At some point of Senator Wehrbein's choosing he would try to get 25 votes to put it back in. My belief is that when we begin to discuss priorities, as Senator Preister began doing, it will be awfully hard, after we've considered the pain that is going to be inflicted through this appropriations bill, to say we're going to nevertheless give \$300,000 to buy some ribbons and some little doodads and whatnots. It's going to be very difficult for him to get 25 votes. Those who favor the fair board, the State Fair, will feel that it's best to get it into the committee amendment that the Appropriations Committee sends out there, because as Senator Wehrbein pointed out accurately, I have to get 25 votes to take it out. So either I'm going to get 25 votes to take it out, or I'm going to get 20 hours to do with whatever I want to. Will I take the full 20 hours? Maybe I'll weaken. Maybe something will happen that can convince me that
