SENATOR CHAMBERS: I don't think so. Some of that is money that goes to other people, probably, than kids. But let me say that it is, so you can continue and ask me the question you want to put to me.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you. And when you talked about, if you didn't get your way again this time that you were going to divide the committee amendment, now was that specifically just on taking the kids' money, or was that on the consent portion of it as well?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Wait a minute. You're asking me...let me state where I am, so that I won't confuse anybody, because...
