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FLOOR DEBATE

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SENATOR CHAMBERS: And adults get some of this money too.

SENATOR BOURNE: Fair enough.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR BOURNE: What about if we don't let the bills go over to consent? Are you going to do the same...?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No.

SENATOR BOURNE: No.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, that's just where the body decided it wants to take each bill in the ordinary course of things. And I don't have any feeling about that one way or the other.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. So the only way that you're going to divide and take up 19 hours on each level of debate is if we don't let you take the kids' and the adults' money from the fair.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Nineteen or more hours. Correct.

SENATOR BOURNE: (Laugh) Exactly. Thank you, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You're welcome.

SENATOR BOURNE: Senator Wehrbein, would you yield to a question or two?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wehrbein, would you res...?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR BOURNE: I kind of want to discuss the prison, specifically LCC.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay.
