SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wehrbein. Or Senator Chambers? Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: How much time? How much time?

SENATOR CUDABACK: About one minute, Senator.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I'm going to collect my thoughts a little more on that, and ask for some time from someone else. Thank you, Senator Landis.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Landis. Senator Thompson. And it will be your third time, Senator.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Thank you. Senator Wehrbein, are you...have you got your thoughts collected? Because I'll yield you...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I'm close. (Laugh)

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...the time right now. Huh?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yeah.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Okay. I yield my time to Senator Wehrbein.
