SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Stuthman. Senator Synowiecki.

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: Senator Janssen, I'd like to yield my time to Senator Bourne.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Senator Bourne, you have 4 minutes and 51.5 seconds.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Mr. President, members. I want to ask Senator Raikes a question or two, and then Senator Wehrbein. And again, I'm trying to flesh out some of the details on the budget in anticipation of some amendments on...either later on General File or on Select File. But before I do that, I want to kind of comment on what Senator Landis talked about. And if you think about this great deal that's been structured here, here's what...here's how I hear it. Senator Wehrbein and others say, go ahead and take out or adopt this amendment, AM3033, so we take \$300,000 from the kids' prize fund, basically, and then Senator Wehrbein is going to run the amendment at a later date, and we'll have 25 votes, I assume, to put it back in, I don't know, and in return for that Senator Chambers is not going to divide the question. That doesn't even really compute, to me. But here's my prediction. This amendment will be adopted, so we'll take \$300,000 from the kids. And I...and I'm an individual who wants more cuts, I'll be honest with you, but we're going to take the kids' prize money away. My next prediction is Senator Landis' LR 209CA will not pass. Senator Landis says that the reason it got 30 votes is because of support for the fair. I don't believe that. I believe it was passed because of clever packaging; that there is a number of individuals here who like to see the Environmental Trust adequately funded, there's also a number of people in here that like to see the education component funded, and there might be a minority of the people in here that want to see the fair funded through that. But anyway, my prediction is that won't go either. So what you're going to do is take \$300,000 from the
