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get some things on the record. When you and Senator Bourne were talking about the possible use of money from the Environmental Trust Fund, you had said you would not be opposed to using \$2.5 million to fund water. But this money that we're talking about in LB 1091 does not go to water measures, does it?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's right. I was speaking to what General...General, Senator Bourne had talked about using the Education Trust Fund.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But would you be opposed to half of this money that is talking...that is discussed in this provision on the last page of the committee amendments,...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...where the money comes from the Education Innovation Fund?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If we would take half that amount from that fund, and half of that amount from the Environmental Trust Fund, would you be opposed to that?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, right off the top of my head, I would because I have an A bill drafted to LB 962 to already take \$2.5 million from Environmental Trust Fund. So I don't think it's necessary to do it here.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But suppose you don't get it for that purpose?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, there's a connection that I hope to connect the body to in that LB 962 that it probably would be more logical than doing it right here or going into General Fund, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So you want to plunder the Education Innovation Fund in order to leave the Environmental Trust Fund available to be plundered for LB 962, using my blunt
