Kremer. Senator Jones, Senator Kremer, Senator Connealy. Senator Kremer, would you check in, please. Senator Jones, the house is under call. Please report to the Chamber. Senator Kremer also. Could everybody please recheck in, if you would, please. We'd appreciate it. Everybody please push their green light again, if you're here. If you're not here, don't push it. Senator Schrock, would you push yours again, please. Senator Brown. Thank you. Senator Landis, would you check yours also. Senator Jones. Senator Tyson and Senator Beutler. We thank you very much. Senator Kremer, if you're here, you could...Senator Kremer and Senator Jones. Senator Wehrbein, would you like to continue, or would you like to wait?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I would continue with the board vote. It would be fine.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Okay. Senator Wehrbein has requested a board vote. The question before the body is adoption of committee amendments, AM3075, to LB 1091. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on adoption of the committee amendments, AM3075, to LB 1091. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 1 nay on adoption of committee amendments.
