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I've seen poor people, black people, Latinos, some Asians who felt that they had to abase themselves in front of white people to get whatever they thought they could get or to avoid having bad things happen to them. Women can tell you, if you are trying to court her and you come sniveling and groveling and doing everything she asks you to do and you're like a little puppy dog, you're no challenge. She doesn't even want to be bothered with you. And I look at this Legislature, and I listen to you. And most of the time I won't respond like this, because you can do whatever you want to. But when some company is coming here and they're going to be praised, they need to know that I am not joining in the praise and the worship. I am a nonbeliever. They're coming here. And somebody said they're going to realize a \$150 million savings over ten years, and that is an incentive. They're not coming here because they like you all. They're not coming here because of some workforce, people working so hard or being so intelligent. They're coming here because it will benefit their company. They make money. They're in business to make a profit. They can make a greater profit by having this operation in Nebraska than they can having it out there on the East Coast, wherever they are. The day that a company comes here at a loss because they love Nebraska, that's the day that you all might can stand up here and praise them. But don't praise when you don't have to. Let them think that you all are people of the world, that this is not the first time a company has come to Nebraska. And you don't have to be converted to worshipful little children, like somebody giving you a lollipop. Act sophisticated if you're not. There are times that companies come here and people with those companies want to meet certain individuals. I don't meet with them. They don't want to meet me as a man or me as a person. They want to know if I'm going to be an enemy, how they need to size me up...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...so they'll know how to counteract whatever I might be in the way of opposition. They didn't write me a letter. They didn't give me a phone call saying, Senator Chambers, good God, man, we respect you and we want to talk to you. They have a gimmick and an angle all the time. I'd like to ask one more question of the Speaker before I stop. Senator
