SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...are we going to work today?

We are discussing the committee amendments. And before the bill can move on, we do have to adopt the committee amendment. But for now, I would urge the adoption of AM2298.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the closing on AM2298, which is an amendment to LB 1047. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on an amendment, AM2298, offered by the Banking, Commerce, and Insurance Committee. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.
