SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wehrbein, to open on that amendment.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, thank you, Mr. President. Members, this is AM3203 amendment. This is, quickly, it's strictly a technical correction. It changes the first sentence in the committee amendments from "Insert the following new section" to "Strike the original sections and insert the following new section." So it's semantics, but it's more correct, and I would urge adoption of this technical amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. You've heard the opening on AM3203, which is an amendment to the committee amendments to LB 1071. Open for discussion. Senator Wehrbein, there are no lights on. You can close on AM3203 if you care to. Senator...he waives the closing. The question before the body is adoption of AM3203, amendment to the committee amendments. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The question directly before the body is the amendment to the committee amendments. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. AM3203 has been adopted. Back to discussion of the committee amendments themselves. Discussion on committee amendments?
