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jurisdiction being taken. So, in order to create that in this situation that I was talking about, the law that would reimburse the innocent third parties, the language would say that "A member of a duly organized state, county or municipal peace unit of another state of the United States," and that word "state" includes the District of Columbia, "who enters this state in fresh pursuit under authority of the Uniform Act on Fresh Pursuit, shall be jointly and severally liable, along with the state, county or municipal peace unit employing the member," meaning that if the member does not have the money to respond in damages then the entity for which he or she worked would be liable. And to the innocent third party who was injured, the action could be brought in the state of Nebraska. No other state has a law that protects its citizens like the law in Nebraska. In order to tighten this whole thing up, I went to the analogy of implied consent. When you drive on the highways, you impliedly give your consent to be stopped, to be required to take these Breathalyzers and so forth. That's the implied consent law. So any of these persons who is engaging in the fresh pursuit and comes into this state shall be deemed to have given his or her consent to be subject to the laws of this state, and such action by the member shall constitute sufficient contact with this state for the exercise of personal jurisdiction over the person. That jurisdiction means not only is the individual subject to the laws of the state, but to the courts of this state. Then, to go further, any state, county, or municipal unit of another state that authorizes its members to enter this state in fresh pursuit shall be deemed to have given its consent to be subject to the laws of the state, and the action of the member constitutes sufficient contact with this state for the exercise of personal jurisdiction over the unit. So you first have the state of Iowa agreeing and authorizing its cops to pursue into Nebraska. By so doing,...

SENATOR HARTNETT: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...they give their consent to be subject to the laws of this state and the jurisdiction of its court. That will give you the hold on the individual. But the unit for which that person works that authorized these pursuits is giving its consent by authorizing the member to do that, to be subject
