SENATOR HARTNETT: The motion was withdrawn. Senator Raikes, would you like to close?

SENATOR RAIKES: I would. Thank you, Mr. President, members. I would ask for a call of the house.

SENATOR HARTNETT: We have a call of the house. Shall the house go under call? Please vote yea or nay. Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR HARTNETT: The house is under call. We have...please record your presence. Senator Hudkins, Senator Jones, Senator Landis, Senator Burling, Senator Kruse, the house is under call. Senator Raikes, would you like to start your close, or you want to wait?

SENATOR RAIKES: I would. Thank you, Mr. President, members. I hope this has been discussed to your satisfaction. This, again, is...(laugh) maybe not everybody's satisfaction, but most of you. This, again, would extend the temporary aid adjustment and the \$1.05 levy lid into the...two years in the out biennium, plus one, so that those two programs, if you will, would have been in place for a total of five years, beginning with the current year. This is something that is difficult but necessary. It's fiscally prudent and I appreciate your consideration of that and urge you to support it. Thank you.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Thank you, Senator Raikes. If you're in favor of the advancement of LB 1093 to E & R Initial please vote yea; opposed vote nay. Have you all voted that would like to vote...care to vote? We're voting on the advancement of LB 1093. Have you all voted that would like to vote? Record.
