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SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Janssen. Senator Stuhr, on AM3256.

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. I just wanted to make a comment on the Seward school bus accident, since that occurred in my district. It really didn't occur in my district. It actually occurred outside of Omaha. But it did involve 19 students, and there were 3 students that were killed in that accident and 1 mother. And I do have a question for Senator Vrtiska.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Vrtiska.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Yes.

SENATOR STUHR: Yes, is that what is...is this claim then going to fall under Section 2, the tort claim?

SENATOR VRTISKA: Yes.

SENATOR STUHR: Is that what you were indicating?

SENATOR VRTISKA: Pardon?

SENATOR STUHR: Is that where it's going to fall? This was one of the latest ones that was brought to you, (inaudible) my understanding.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Well, you're talking about the last one that was filed?

SENATOR STUHR: The Seward...the Seward...

SENATOR VRTISKA: Yes.

SENATOR STUHR: ...school bus, yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA: The other ones were settled earlier and then we have coming up the last one that was settled just recently.
