SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Discussion on the bill itself? Discussion on advancement of LB 1241? Seeing no lights on, Senator Vrtiska, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. I think we've had a good discussion on this bill and I think we've taken some steps that probably are important. And with that, I would ask for you to advance this bill. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the closing on advancement of LB 1241. The question before the body is, shall LB 1241 advance to E & R Initial? All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Voting on advancement of LB 1241. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1241.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 1241 does advance. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. I have amendments to be printed: Legislative Bill, Senator Brown, to LB 625; Senator Landis to LB 1017. Enrollment and Review reports LB 962 and LB 962A to Select File. And a new resolution, LR 278, by Senator Schrock calls for an interim study. That will be referred to the Executive Board. That's all that I had, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1189-1194.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Next agenda item, General File, 2004 senator priority bills. Mr. Clerk, first bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1083, a bill originally introduced by Senator Jensen. It's a bill for an act relating to behavioral health services. The bill has been discussed on the floor on
