March 17. At that time, Mr. President, there was a request for a division of the committee amendments. The committee amendments were divided into multiple components. The first portion of the committee amendments, FA1517, was considered and adopted. At this time, Mr. President, I have the next component of the committee amendments, FA1574, pending. (Legislative Journal page 1126.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Jensen, in the interest of time, would you take about 30 seconds or a minute or whatever and brief us on the bill itself?

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes, thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I first want to mention that there have been negotiations going on, intensive, for the last week since this bill first came up. We spent three hours on it. And we have come to an agreement which is being circulated and signed and will be turned in momentarily, that an amendment will follow this introduction. But we began discussions on Section 10, which is FA1574, which is really the main part of the bill, describes how a transition will take place, and that is where we are at this present time, and I'll speak more on the bill when given the opportunity. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jensen. Mr. Clerk, amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment I have to FA1574, which is the second component of the committee amendment, Senator Connealy, AM3218.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Connealy.

SENATOR CONNEALY: I'd like to withdraw that.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, the second amendment to this component is, Senator Connealy, AM3219.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Connealy.
