happen. You talked earlier about Hastings and the facility at Norfolk, that they will remain open to take care of the severely...the severe cases. Well, when you get down to a certain number, then they probably will close. But the problem isn't going to go away that easy. They're still going to be with our society, the way it is today, and a lot of that is coming from methamphetamines, and I know that. These poor people are in a bad situation. So until I can see in black and white, and you're starting to explain it and that's fine, but I cannot go back to my district and say, well, you still may have to put some of these people in a jail because we don't have a place for them, or take them to the hospital where...and the local hospital doesn't have a facility to take care of these people. That's my concern, and I hope that you...you're starting on the right track with your amendment. I hope I can end up voting for this in the end. I want to, but I don't want to put a burden back on my hospital and our county sheriff. Senator Jensen, you've worked on this a long time, the committee has worked on it a long time and, yes, it's probably the best situation, but until I'm convinced that it is a best situation for everyone, I am going to be a little reluctant in supporting it. But with a few more hours, maybe you can convince me. Thank you.
