SENATOR STUHR: Committee.

SENATOR JENSEN: ...advisory committee to the council.

SENATOR STUHR: All right. Do we have a State Behavioral Health Council at present?

SENATOR JENSEN: No.

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR STUHR: Well, I was wondering if you would...I don't know how much thought, how much deliberation has been given in this. It would seem to me if you're only having 12 members on a state advisory committee, and then selecting 10 of those 12 members, that possibly that could be reduced to 5 members from each of those committees, leaving that health council at 20 members instead of the 30. I don't know, think about that. I'm thinking about...

SENATOR JENSEN: Yeah.

SENATOR STUHR: ...30 members on this council, and I know...I'm thinking about the State Fair and some of the problems that they had with such a large council.

SENATOR JENSEN: Boy, I appreciate what you're saying and maybe we can visit about that before...

SENATOR STUHR: Yes.

SENATOR JENSEN: ...now and Select, and see if there's some agreement that we can come to and look at this number.
