SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wehrbein,...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: ...would you yield?

SENATOR BROWN: I know that sometimes the Medicaid rules change a little bit about whether this...what they approve. And sometimes they change it even after they've approved it. Is this within the parameters of what we can use that intergovernmental transfer money for?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I am sure it is. I have not checked that specific question, but I'm sure...I'll check that for...

SENATOR BROWN: Okay.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...absolute certainly.

SENATOR BROWN: Thank you.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I have a nod from staff that it is, but...

SENATOR BROWN: Thanks.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I didn't see Jeff nod, (laugh) but if there's a problem, I'll let you know. But I'm pretty sure it is.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Brown.

SENATOR BROWN: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: No further discussion? Senator Wehrbein, to close. He waives closing. The question before the body is AM3065, offered by Senator Wehrbein to LB 1083A. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the Wehrbein amendment, AM3065, to LB 1083A. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.
