SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jensen, to open on your amendment, AM3135.

SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President. This is yet another bill that Senator Byars was bringing forward, and this is a public health cleanup. Actually, Senator Byars had worked so hard in this area, and this should have been in an earlier amendment on General File, and it was an oversight. But it is a clarification for health departments that are over 50,000 people, the requirement that they may be either on (sic) county or (sic) that population, or three contiguous counties with that population. The Department of Health and Human Services supports this amendment, and Senator Byars certainly does agree that this clarification is needed. I would just ask that this be adopted. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jensen. You've heard the opening on AM3135 to LB 1005. Open for discussion on that motion by Senator Jensen. Senator Jensen, there's no...he waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of AM3135, offered by Senator Jensen to LB 1005. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is the Jensen amendment, AM3135, to LB 1005. Have you all voted who wish to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Jensen's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further on the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Mossey, for a motion. Is Senator Mossey present? I'm sorry, you are there. Senator Mossey, a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 1005 to E & R for engrossing.
