SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I understand that, but it must be, what...do you remember the dollar number? Because that has been a fluctuating number in the Ethanol Board, and I was wondering where it's going to be kind of frozen, if you will, or steadied.

SENATOR CONNEALY: No, I think it still stays in a declining state, or a steady state, now that we're using denatured. The decline in off-road use would...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I understand all the background.

SENATOR CONNEALY: Yeah.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I was just wondering what the dollar amount was going to end up being. As I recall, it's \$400,000 or \$500,000 that we use for the Ethanol Board, \$300,000? Okay. So that, it's to maintain around a \$300,000, give or take, to funding of the Ethanol Board, which I concur with. I was just trying to see exactly what the impact was. That's all (inaudible).

SENATOR CONNEALY: It's written to be revenue neutral, the same amount as is there now.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Further discussion? Senator Bourne.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Mr. President, members. Would Senator Connealy yield to a question or two, please?

SENATOR CONNEALY: Yes.
