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I didn't have time to listen to everything you said. But I heard you say...

SENATOR JANSSEN: Do you want me to repeat that, Senator?
(Laugh)

SENATOR VRTISKA: I was cleaning up the pop I spilled. I didn't hear everything you said, but I thought when you were talking something was said about the money from some of the license would go to a village and a city. Is that right?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Yes, some...none of it changes, Senator. They go to the same place they always have. (Inaudible).

SENATOR VRTISKA: There's no change in that. That's the way it's been.

SENATOR JANSSEN: That...it is the same.

SENATOR VRTISKA: That's a special license, right?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay. I just wanted to make sure I understood it, because I didn't catch all of it, but I appreciate that. So I don't have a problem with that. So thank you, Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. Senator Louden.

SENATOR LOUDEN: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I'd like to ask Senator Janssen questions, if I could, please.
