SENATOR JANSSEN:    Yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA:    Senator Janssen, I've had time to review this sheet that you sent out and I was curious. Class B license went from \$25 to \$100, is that right?

SENATOR JANSSEN:    Which one?

SENATOR VRTISKA:    Class B license, beer only, went from \$25 to \$100.

SENATOR JANSSEN:    Right, uh-huh.

SENATOR VRTISKA:    And a Class C from \$250 to \$300?

SENATOR JANSSEN:    Yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA:    And on...and a Class D for inside the villages, et cetera, is \$150 to \$200?

SENATOR JANSSEN:    That's right.

SENATOR VRTISKA:    On the Class A, it says \$10 to \$100 in 1935, and it's \$100 now. I don't understand that. Depends on the size of the village or the city?

SENATOR JANSSEN:    Yes, that depends upon what size the city or village is.

SENATOR VRTISKA:    Well, then...

SENATOR JANSSEN:    That's been in statute before.

SENATOR VRTISKA:    The question I have then, a Class A license will be \$100 no matter what the size of the community is. Is that correct?

SENATOR JANSSEN:    Yes, that's beer only on premises inside the cities and village only; the fees vary based upon size of municipality, that is.
