SENATOR VRTISKA: So it will be \$100, irregardless.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Yes.

I was just trying to see what the rationale for some of the differences was, and I guess it explains itself, and I have to agree that it's certainly not anything sinister about raising them up that much after 60-some years. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Janssen's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Motion was successful. The amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Back to discussion of the bill itself, advancement to E & R Initial. Senator Janssen, there are no lights on. You're recognized to close on advancement.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback, members. This has been a couple, two, three years in the making, trying to get something that was palatable to most people. It was something that I think needed to be done, if nothing else, getting the classifications in...grouped into one group, and we did raise the fees to some extent.
