CLERK: 30 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 485.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 485 does advance. We will go to the A bill now, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 485A by Senator Janssen. (Read title.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Janssen, to open on LB 485A.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback, members. As you know, every bill that then makes changes in the computers, and so on, does carry a fiscal note. This fiscal note, though, I believe over time will group itself and there will be more dollars that will be brought into the cities, villages, and counties, wherever they are. So it's something that needed to be addressed: It is going to cost some money on changes on the fiscal note. With that, I ask for your support of the fiscal note.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Janssen. You've heard the opening on LB 485A to E & R Initial. Open for discussion on that motion. Seeing no lights on, Senator Janssen. He waives closing. The question before the body is advancement of LB 485A to E & R Initial. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is advancement of LB 485A. CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 485A.
