The question before the body is adoption of the committee amendments to LB 1045. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Try this here. (Rang bell.) You heard it. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The committee amendments are adopted.
