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that's all this amendment does. And I would yield the rest of my time to Senator Brashear.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Brashear, you have seven minutes.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. Thank you, Senator Beutler. I do appreciate very much Senator Beutler's input on the bill, and frankly was more than happy to be able to work it out so that we can continue to make the progress that I first talked about when I introduced this bill on General File. This is the first major rewrite of our notaries public statutes in 30 years. And there truly are problems out there, so to speak, abroad in the land, as we become more advanced, and all that sort of thing. And I think this is something that will bring credibility to the body, to the laws, and to the practice of being a notary public. I was happy to delete the one section, for the reasons that Senator Beutler indicated. And by doing that, why, he was willing to accommodate another section that I think will allow us to better serve our...particularly our growing immigrant population. And so I thank you for your time and attention. I would urge you to adopt the amendment and advance the bill. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Brashear. You've heard the opening on FA1586 by Senator Brashear and Senator Beutler. Discussion? Seeing no lights on, Senator Beutler, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I think the amendment has been explained, and so I won't go further into the amendment. But I might mention to you, I think, although this hasn't been discussed, that this bill has a positive homeland security kind of effect also, in terms of being sure that...being more sure, at least, or trying to implement provisions that have the tendency to validate particular documents of one type or another. So it has that positive aspect too, the bill in general. And I'd simply recommend the amendment to you, and recommend that we move forward with this. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. The question before the body is adoption of FA1586 by Senator Brashear and
