SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Byars, to open on AM3095 to LB 845.

SENATOR BYARS: Thank you, Mr. President. A cleanup amendment, a little bit more than E & R could do. But E & R came back with a recommendation that, unlike some time-share estate programs, not all time-share programs have owners associations. But they're both required to have a managing agent. So this amendment assures that there is a responsible party to provide the proxy, with a mailing right to the time-share owners. Very simple, recommended by E & R, but just a little more than an E & R amendment. So I would recommend the amendment to LB 845.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Byars. You've heard the opening on AM3095 to LB 845. Open for discussion on that motion. There are no lights on. Senator Byars. He waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of AM3095 by Senator Byars to LB 845. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the Byars amendment, AM3095, to LB 845. Have you all voted on the amendment who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Byars' amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 845 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion to advance LB 845 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed to the motion say nay. It is advanced.

CLERK: LB 884, Senator. I do have Enrollment and Review amendments. (AM7194, Legislative Journal page 1047.)
